We have been learning this week!

The children have continued to settle into nursery well and have loved exploring both the indoor and outdoor provision. This week, the children have been developing their gross motor skills by climbing on the frame and building obstacle courses with crates and planks. We have also been practising throwing and catching balls with our hands and bats—it was wonderful to hear some fantastic counting as we caught the balls together.

Indoors, we have seen some amazing dinosaur houses, caves, and dens in our construction area. In the role-play kitchen, we have enjoyed plenty of pizza, spaghetti, and Saku. It has been lovely to see the children bringing their experiences from home into nursery.

During song time, the children have been counting, joining in with actions, and we have loved seeing so many take part with excitement.

-All medication must be stored in our locked medicine cupboard and not in children's bags. If your child requires medication during the day, written consent must be provided—please speak to a staff member. Please ensure no medication (e.g., Movicol) is placed in children's bottles. If your child needs medication in their bottles, speak to a staff member who will ensure it is given directly to your child and safely stored away from others.
