



# Junior 4 and 5 Newsletter

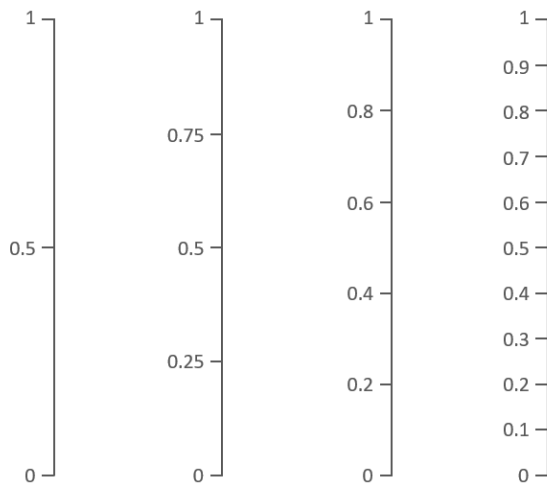

## Our Learning

This is the maths learning we've been trying to remember this week!



When converting fractions into decimals, we divide one between the equal parts.

$$\frac{1}{2} = 1 \div 2 = 0.5$$

$$\frac{1}{4} = 1 \div 4 = 0.25$$

$$\frac{1}{5} = 1 \div 5 = 0.2$$

$$\frac{1}{10} = 1 \div 10 = 0.1$$

**Wed 17<sup>th</sup> June – Wear your team's colours** (To celebrate the first England game of the world cup).

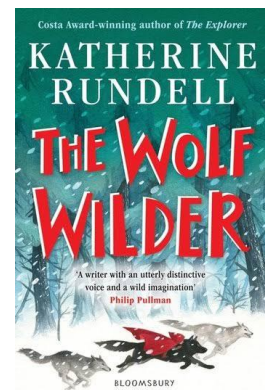
**Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June – Democracy Day** – Year 6s need to have speeches prepared (if they want to put themselves forward)
