This week in Maths, we have started a new unit on Shape and Measure. Year 3 children have been exploring shapes using geoboards, while Year 4 children have been learning how to measure accurately in centimetres and millimetres. In English, we have continued our shared write on The Crow's Tale fable. Focusing on developing rich vocabulary and structure. A highlight of the week was a visit from Skem Heritage, who brought WW2 history to life with fascinating artefacts and stories. We have focused on the topic of evacuation in history, deepening our understanding of what life was like for children during the war. In Spanish, we've been practising reading, writing and speaking words for animals, building confidence in both pronunciation and spelling. This week in Science, we carried out an experiment to observe how shadows are formed using different types of materials—lots of curious observations and great discussion!


