## **TEKKEN 8**

WHAT ARE THE RISKS? Thirty years after its debut on the original PlayStation, the Tekken franchise is back with its eighth mainstream instalment. A one-on-one fighting game series in the same vein as Street Fighter and Mortal Kombat, Tekken 8 can be commended for its relative lack of in-game purchases – but there's still plenty to consider in keeping young players safe from potential hazards.

#### **FUTURE SPENDING?**

Teldon 5 comes a PEOI Is rating, with the assessors noting its violence, occasional profunity and in-game purchase options. The latter issue, however, is a Sittle eitherent to what you may expect from a modern game, unlike many high-poolie releases. Teldon 5'is content is all accessible without spending any extre money. The exceptions are new characters, which will become available to purchase separately in the lineare.

#### COPYCAT RISK

With characters flying across the screen using a misture of authoritic and lentestical lighting styles, younger children and impressionable team may find themselves tempted to copy their factorite characters or out out their epic lights in real file. This could simply amount to harmless tun—but could also easily lead to accidents, injury and distress if young general text activation in least.

#### **VIOLENT GAMEPLAY**

As a lighting game, Tekken B's gameplay is hearly based on punching, sloking and throwing apparents around - while some characters attacks occasionally involve weapons. Most of the violence is comparatively contaonable in its assectation and lacking in gare, but the fact remains that the action still revolves entirely around intense combat and inflicting damage on an apponent.

#### **FAMILY CONFLICT**

Telden B's story mode, 'The Dark Awakens', focuse on two of the series' most important characters - Kazaya and Jin, a father and son who have been warning for years. The sight of two tarnily members physically fighting each other may be hard to understand (and difficult to deal with) for some children - causing confusion and concern over why relatives would went to hard one contine.

#### RANKED ONLINE PLAY

Tekken if features an array of online modes most notably its "tanked" section, where players battle to reach the top spot of a worldwide leaderboard. Many players will dedicate significant amounts of time to practising and while the challenge can be fun — some of these matches can get extremely competitive. Children could become observed with climbing the rankings, and dedicate an unheatiny amount of time to the game or gave angry if they wind up on a losing streak.

#### ONLINE CONTACT

Takken 8 doesn't ofter voice chat by default, but a player's platform 10 is visible (such as their Playsaction herwork 10, steam account or Xear gameriag). Rivel players can, therefore, reach out via missages II they wish. Given the gamers Beroety compective nature, these communications can potentially put children at risk of online abuse if their apparent is a particularly sore loses.

### Advice for Parents & Educators

#### TRY IT OUT YOURSELF

As with many popular games, see'd recommend checking it out for yourself in advance if you have any concerns. In the case of Tekken 5, there's a free demo version available (for as plotforms) which lors you experience lights with a handlul of the characters: a useful way of establishing first-hand whether some children might find the game's violence to be too interns.

#### MARTIAL ARTS MOTIVATION?

With characters utilizing real-world lighting styles such as Jurifitia, basing and kickboxing. Tekken could represent an apportunity to channel a child's fundress for the game into a beneficial interest in real-world martial arts. Classes can help to build young people's confidence and physical fitness, as well as providing avenues for making new friends.

#### EXERCISE YOUR JUDGEMENT

While Tokken 8 leatures a sort of Spray' impact effect when attacks land, it's not the kind of game that most observers would describe as gary (unlike, for instance the Nortal Kembot franchise). Of course, any lighting game worthy of the name will include a significant degree of violance – but the level at which the battles in Tekken are pitched may not be an issue for some children.

#### CONTROL COMMUNICATIONS

If a child plays Takken online with anyone apart from their friends, then parents and corers could consider restricting communications – such as shutting off the locality to be messaged by other players (although the child's profile name will still be displayed) – to reduce the chance of contract from exangers. This can be done via the console's account settings or through the child's Steam account (I playing on PC).
