Home Learning:

This week we have been practising writing multiples of ten correctly e.g: 10, 20, 30, 40. We have also been counting in tens forwards and backwards. Sometimes, we have been saying 'seven-teen' instead of 'seven-ty' so we have worked hard to distinguish between these multiples of ten and the 'teen' numbers! We have used

Next week's Learning:

Maths: Y1 will begin to explore fractions. They will learn that a fraction is a part of a whole and when all those parts are equal in size, we can begin to name them e.g: 'half'. Y2 will be exploring block graphs and data, answering questions about the information presented.
