Home Learning:

Phonics home learning has been sent home today. Y1 have their phonics screening check next week.

In maths we will be partitioning numbers into tens and ones. You can practise this like the equations below:

$$34 = 30+4 \quad 48 = 40+8 \quad 31 = 30+1$$

Y2: Can you make an amount in different ways e.g. 34 is also = 20+14, 10+24

Next week's learning:

Maths: We will be working on composing and decomposing 2-digit numbers and separating these numbers into tens and ones. We will then be moving on to identifying which multiple of ten is either side of a 2-digit number e.g. 36 is between 30 and 40.

English: We will start a new book focus: The Day the Crayons Quit!

Science: We will be learning more about oceans and caring for different bodies of water.

Geography: We will be learning the names of the bodies of water around the UK: Atlantic Ocean, Irish Sea, North Sea and English Channel

PSHE: We will understand how to keep money safe.
