Summary of Results

201 parents completed questionnaires at parents evening in October 2025

- 99% of parents say their child is happy in school - strongly agree (86%) or agree (13%).
- 100% of parents feel their child is safe in school (86% of parents strongly agree and 14% agree).
- 100% of parents say the behaviour of children at Cobbs Brow is of a good standard (strongly agree 86% or agree 14%).
- 100% of parents feel their child is making good progress in school (strongly agree 91% or agree 9%).
- The majority of parents strongly agree (76%) or agree (21%) that their child receives regular home learning.
- Parents strongly agree (83%) or agree (17%) that school helps to support them with their child's learning.
- 99% of parents say that they are kept adequately informed about progress in their child's education (strongly agree 83% or agree 17%)
- Parents strongly agree (64%) or agree (22%) that they feel encouraged to become involved in school activities and workshops. 3.5% (7 parents) disagreed with this statement.
- Parents strongly agree (79%) or agree (187) that staff listening to them, respecting their views and acting upon recommendations.
- 100% of parents would recommend Cobbs Brow Primary to another parent (strongly agree 90% or agree 10%)
